



US Stock Market

U.S. stocks finished lower on Tuesday, breaking a three-session string of record closing highs, as Federal Reserve Chair Jerome Powell said the U.S. central bank needs to balance inflation concerns with a weakening job market in its coming interest rate decisions.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average (.DJI), fell 88.76 points, or 0.19%, to 46,292.78, the S&P 500 (.SPX), lost 36.83 points, or 0.55%, to 6,656.92 and the Nasdaq Composite (.IXIC), lost 215.50 points, or 0.95%, to 22,573.47.

The three major U.S. indexes registered record closing highs for the previous three sessions.

Declining issues outnumbered advancers by a 1.12-to-1 ratio on the NYSE. There were 561 new highs and 86 new lows on the NYSE.

On the Nasdaq, 1,786 stocks rose and 2,871 fell as declining issues outnumbered advancers by a 1.61-to-1 ratio.

Volume on U.S. exchanges was 18.89 billion shares, compared with the 17.66 billion average for the full session over the last 20 trading days.

Dow Jones Industrial Average

At the close in NYSE, the Dow Jones Industrial Average declined 0.19%. The best performers of the session on the Dow Jones Industrial Average were Boeing Co (NYSE:BA), which rose 2.01% or 4.26 points to trade at 216.35 at the close. Meanwhile, Unitedhealth Group (NYSE:UNH) added 1.91% or 6.53 points to end at 347.83 and 3M Company (NYSE:MMM) was up 1.58% or 2.43 points to 156.29 in late trade.

The worst performers of the session were Amazon.com Inc (NASDAQ:AMZN), which fell 3.03% or 6.89 points to trade at 220.74 at the close. NVIDIA Corporation (NASDAQ:NVDA) declined 2.82% or 5.18 points to end at 178.43 and Salesforce Inc (NYSE:CRM) was down 2.03% or 5.07 points to 244.62.

NASDAQ 100

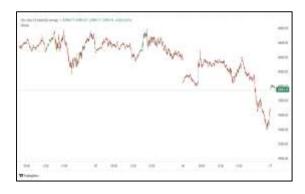
At the close in NYSE, the NASDAQ Composite index declined 0.95%. The top performers on the NASDAQ Composite were Super League Enterprise Inc (NASDAQ:SLE) which rose 159.45% to 8.51, Innovation Beverage Group Ltd (NASDAQ:IBG) which was up 105.07% to settle at 0.76 and Datavault Al Inc (NASDAQ:DVLT) which gained 80.07% to close at 0.74.

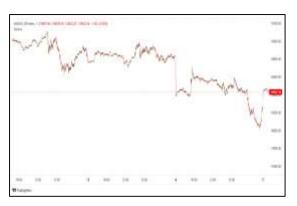
The worst performers were Fitness Champs Holdings Ltd (NASDAQ:FCHL) which was down 84.17% to 1.10 in late trade, Boxlight Corp Class A (NASDAQ:BOXL) which lost 40.04% to settle at 2.86 and Inno Holdings Inc (NASDAQ:INHD) which was down 39.89% to 2.26 at the close.

OIL

Oil prices rose for a second day on Wednesday as an industry report showed U.S. crude inventories declined last week, adding to a sense in the market of tightening supplies.

Brent futures rose 19 cents, or 0.3%, to \$67.82 a barrel by 0400 GMT. U.S. West Texas Intermediate crude futures gained 21 cents, or 0.3%, to \$63.62.











Precious and Base Metals

Gold held steady near record high on Wednesday as investors assessed U.S. Federal Reserve Chair Jerome Powell's cautious remarks on potential interest rate cuts and awaited U.S. inflation data due later in the week, while mild profit booking added pressure.

Spot gold held its ground at \$3,765.29 per ounce, as of 0403 GMT. Bullion hit a record high of \$3,790.82 on Tuesday. U.S. gold futures for December delivery fell 0.5% to \$3,798.50.

Gold's relative strength index (RSI) stood at 78, indicating that the metal was overbought.

Spot silver edged up 0.2% at \$44.11 per ounce, platinum rose 0.4% to \$1,484.36 and palladium gained 1% at \$1,231.85.





Traditional Agricultures

Soybean futures came back on Tuesday to close with fractional to 3 ½ cent gains, led by the deferreds. The cmdtyView national average Cash Bean price was 1 ½ cents higher at \$9.36 3/4.

Corn futures closed out the Tuesday trade session with contracts up 2 1/2 to 4 1/2 cents cross the board. The CmdtyView national average Cash Corn price is up 2 1/4 cents at \$3.80 1/4.

The wheat market saw strength on Tuesday, as all three exchanges were higher on Tuesday. CBT soft red wheat futures were 8 to 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ cents in the green on the day. KC HRW futures posted 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ cent gains at the close. MPLS spring wheat futures closed the Tuesday session with contracts up 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ to 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ cents.
